In the past, we have seen AVast!, AVG, among others offer free realtime virus protection and automated updates. A while back, Microsoft introduced the freely available Microsoft Security Essentials which also performs real-time protection, scheduled scanning and automated updates.

So let's go over the basic premise.

There are hackers out there and they are a smart and crafty bunch. There is little doubt that if you are clicking links within emails or employing any search engine to direct your travels on the net that eventually you will encounter a carefully constructed web site designed to trick you or your child into running a program on your PC.
